Center of activities will be the Schoolhouse Bar and surrounding area. Live music will begin after the parade.

- No alcohol to be consumed by parade entries during the parade (for insurance reasons.)
- May not use water spraying devices.
- Candy cannot be thrown from parade entries, but may be handed out by representatives walking alongside (for safety reasons.)
- Parade will not have a theme other than Memorial Day and will not be a contest with judges.

MABA will be organizing food and refreshment stands and live music for a fun-filled afternoon. Children's activities will take place in the park adjacent to the Schoolhouse Bar.
